

**DISCOVERING PERU**  
SUGGESTED ITINERARY FOR A 5 DAYS/4 NIGHTS TRIP TO PERU

Marvelous sights and experiences await you in your upcoming visit to Cusco. Get inspired by the following suggested itinerary and do not hesitate to contact us should you be ready to explore our magical destination:

**Day 1 LIMA**

Upon arrival to Lima, a private transfer will be taking you to the JW Marriott Hotel Lima, located in the trendy Miraflores district. Enjoy a spectacular ocean view from your room along with the intuitive service that our associates are ready to provide. You may relax the rest of your day enjoying our dining options or you can also visit the Larcomar Shopping Center, located across the hotel. Optional: Enjoy a panoramic city tour, explore the delicious Peruvian gastronomy, visit The Magic Water Circuit, located in the Parque de la Reserva and/or visit the pre-Inca ruin, Huaca Pucllana, an enormous adobe pyramid, located in the Miraflores district.

**Day 2 CUSCO**

Delve into a world of mysticism in the Imperial City of Cusco, where you will stay at the JW Marriott Hotel Cusco. It was built over the old Colonial Convent of San Agustín from the 16th century and carefully restored. Its archaeological remains from the Pre- Inca to the Contemporary period can be admired in two exhibition halls. You will have a magical experience surrounded by the mysticism of the city and the Inca culture. Enjoy a half-day Cusco city tour, a living example of the mixture of the Andean and Spanish cultures. We start our trip visiting the Cathedral and then we head to the Convent of Santo Domingo, built over the Koricancha, which was an ancient Inca palace and the principal temple to worship the Sun God. Later, visit the fortress of Sacsayhuaman, an imposing sample of Cyclopean architecture. Finally, we will visit the archaeological sites of Kenko, Puca-Pucara and Tambomachay.

**Day 3 SACRED VALLEY**

Enjoy the stunning landscape of the Sacred Valley of the Incas. Visit the Inca handcraft market in Pisac, where we will have the chance to meet its people, their traditions and handicrafts. Afterwards, we will head for Urubamba, driving over the Vilcanota River. Enjoy lunch at a restaurant in the Sacred Valley of the Incas and then visit the fortress and citadel of Ollantaytambo, built to watch and protect the entrance of that side of the valley. Here we will have the chance to walk by the narrow streets and have a clear sight of how this military, religious and cultural center was during the Inca Empire.



#### Day 4 MACHU PICCHU

Begin your mystical journey to Machu Picchu, one of the New Seven Wonders. According to your preference, you may depart from Poroy station or from Ollantaytambo town to Machu Picchu town. In Machu Picchu town (Aguas Calientes) we will take the bus, to ascend 400m (30 minutes) and reach the famous citadel of Machu Picchu, where we will conduct a guided visit. This citadel was built totally of stone blocks, fitted with masterful precision. In this fabulous city you will find houses, temples, warehouses, a large central square, all connected by narrow roads and steps. We will descend by bus to Machu Picchu town (Aguas Calientes) to take the train back to your chosen station. Please be at the train station 30 minutes in advance for your train departure. Once you arrive to your station, a private transportation will be waiting for you to take you to the JW Marriott Hotel Cusco.
