

**DISCOVERING PERU**  
SUGGESTED ITINERARY FOR A 6 DAYS/5 NIGHTS TRIP TO PERU

Marvelous sights and experiences await you in your upcoming visit to Cusco. Get inspired by the following suggested itinerary and do not hesitate to contact us should you be ready to explore our magical destination:

**Day 1 LIMA**

Upon arrival to Lima, a private transfer will be taking you to the JW Marriott Hotel Lima, located in the trendy Miraflores district. Enjoy a spectacular ocean view from your room along with the intuitive service that our associates are ready to provide. You may relax the rest of your day enjoying our dining options or you can also visit the Larcomar Shopping Center, located across the hotel. Optional: Enjoy a panoramic city tour, explore the delicious Peruvian gastronomy, visit The Magic Water Circuit, located in the Parque de la Reserva and visit the pre-Inca ruin, Huaca Pucllana, an enormous adobe pyramid, located in the Miraflores district.

**Day 2 CUSCO**

Delve into a world of mysticism in the Imperial City of Cusco where you will stay at the JW Marriott Hotel Cusco. It was built over the old Colonial Convent of San Agustín in the 16th century, and carefully restored. Its archaeological remains from the Pre- Inca to the Contemporary period can be admired in two exhibition halls. You will have a magical experience surrounded by the mysticism of the city and the Inca culture. Enjoy a half-day Cusco city tour, a living example of the mixture of the Andean and Spanish cultures. We start our trip visiting the Cathedral and then we head to the Convent of Santo Domingo, built over the Koricancha, which was an ancient Inca palace and the principal temple to worship the Sun God. Later, visit the fortress of Sacsayhuaman, an imposing sample of Cyclopean architecture. Finally, we will visit the archaeological sites of Kenko, Puca-Pucara and Tambomachay.

**Day 3 CUSCO – SACRED VALLEY**

Enjoy the magical trip to Maras, where the salt mines are located, constituted by about 3000 small wells, with an average area of 5m<sup>2</sup> each. During the time of droughts, they fill or water the wells every 3 days, producing a natural pink salt. Nowadays that salt is being iodized and this is the reason why its consumption is healthier.

Later, we will have lunch at a restaurant in Moray which is a unique archaeological site located on a plateau, the ancient Inca site of Moray consists of many terraced circular depressions in the earth, being the largest of 30 meters (98 feet) deep. The difference in temperature between the top and the bottom of the circles helps to adapt different types of plants and vegetables.



#### **Day 4 MACHU PICCHU**

Begin the mystical journey to Machu Picchu, one of the New Seven Wonders. A private tour guide will take you to the train station. According to your preference, you may depart from Poroy station or from Ollantaytambo town to Machu Picchu town. In Aguas Calientes, we will take the bus, to ascend 400m (30 minutes) and reach the famous citadel of Machu Picchu, where we will conduct a guided visit. This citadel was built totally of stone blocks, fitted with masterful precision. In this fabulous city you will find houses, temples, warehouses, a large central square, all connected by narrow roads and steps. We will descend by bus to Aguas Calientes and your private tour guide will escort you to your luxury accommodation in Machu Picchu town. Enjoy à-la-carte dinner.

#### **Day 5 MACHU PICCHU**

Day at leisure to enjoy at your own pace, optional excursions available: experience contemplative walks to sacred sites, or attempt a challenging Andean ascent. On the hotel grounds, soak in nature trails winding past waterfalls and gardens. Discover a working tea plantation, and the world's largest private collection of indigenous orchids, open to the public. Please be at the train station 30 minutes in advance for your train departure. Once you arrive to the train station, a private transportation will be waiting for you to take you to the JW Marriott Hotel Cusco.
